- When and where? We are gathering **at 11am off the Coffin Path** on the south side of the A2 more or less opposite the Blinds Company. (map below).  
The more the merrier, to help reinforce how much we all value our *Green Spaces* – all ages, dog walkers, friends and family on you way to Sunday Lunch?  
Please spread the word and I hope to see you there. The whole event shouldn't take too long once we have gathered.
- There is no parking at this point, so if you are using your car try down Frogmal Lane (not Frogmal Gardens, which is very narrow).
- The idea is for as many Kent communities as possible to show our need for protected Green Spaces that benefit us in so many ways.  
Photographs from across Kent will be shared widely online and with local newspapers.
- The photocall will take place on the “Coffin Path” against the background of the fields south of the A2.  
I believe a wicker coffin filled with apples and a banner will be the ‘centre piece’ for the photocall ... this is a good metaphor for the threat to our rich green spaces and our historic link with orchards and food production on the highest quality land that surrounds our communities.



Our protest photocall is running in tandem with one taking place *at the same time* in Teynham Parish.
